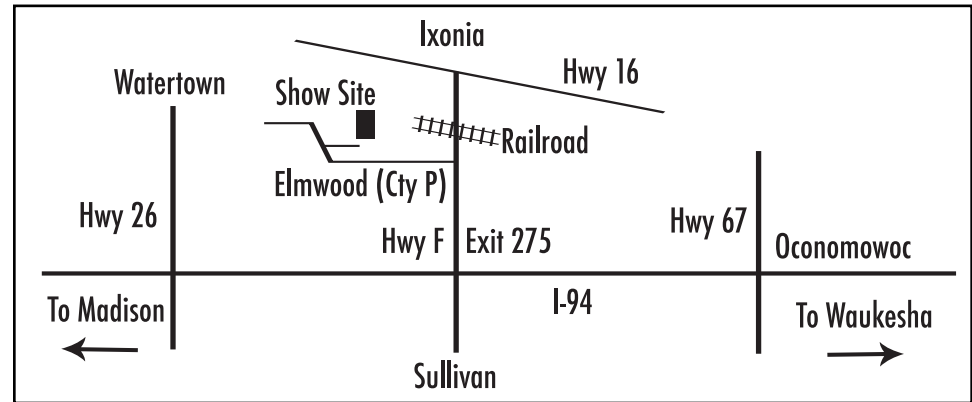

Entry Information

Any entry **not** on an **Official AKC Entry Form** which does not include the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side or without fees or signatures will **not** be accepted. Proof of transmission is **not** proof of receipt (AKC Rules, Chapter 11, Section 4). A returned check does not constitute a valid entry fee.

Owners are responsible for any errors in making out their entry forms. No refunds will be awarded for said errors or for duplicate entries.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing (email acceptable) or by telegram only prior to the closing date and time of entries.

Checks and money orders must be payable in U.S. Funds and made out to **GMNEA**.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The club will add a \$20.00 collection fee to each returned check.

No entry fee will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.

Bitches in Season

Bitches in season are not allowed in Obedience or Rally. If dog comes in season, notification to show secretary with a veterinarian certificate at least 1/2 hour prior to judging. A refund will be made less \$5.00 administrative fee.

Judging

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

Dog not required for further judging will be excused.

Grounds

Rings are fully matted.

There is ample parking.

All dogs must be on leash or in their crates when on the show grounds.

The show giving Club, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by the exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

Parents are responsible for supervising their children.

Owners and Handlers are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs and children and maintaining the cleanliness of their grooming area.

No Smoking in the building.

No dogs may be left in the building overnight.

Please stack crates; No exercise pens; No unentered dogs. Puppies and dogs not entered in the show will not be permitted inside the show building.

I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance there to, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim: and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim or loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by the law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents or any other persons.

I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering: i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color); Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.); Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wire-haired); Collies (rough, smooth); Bull Terriers (colored, white); Manchester Terriers (standard, toy); Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat); Poodles (toy, miniature, standard); English Toy Spaniels (King Charles & Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best in Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record, and dogs, which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Championships in Best in Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e.: age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
