NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Entry Information

Any entry **not** on an **Official AKC Entry Form** which does not include the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side or without fees or signatures will **not** be accepted. Proof of transmission is **not** proof of receipt (AKC Rules, Chapter 11, Section 4). A returned check does not constitute a valid entry fee.

Owners are responsible for any errors in making out their entry forms. No refunds will be awarded for said errors or for duplicate entries.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing (email acceptable) or by telegram only prior to the closing date and time of entries.

Checks and money orders must be payable in U.S. Funds and made out to **GMNEA**.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The club will add a \$20.00 collection fee to each returned check.

No entry fee will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.

Bitches in Season

Bitches in season are not allowed in Obedience or Rally. If dog comes in season, notification to show secretary with a veterinarian certificate at least 1/2 hour prior to judging. A refund will be made less \$5.00 administrative fee.

Judging

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

Dog not required for further judging will be excused.

Grounds

Rings are fully matted.

There is ample parking.

All dogs must be on leash or in their crates when on the show grounds.

The show giving Club, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by the exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

Parents are responsible for supervising their children.

Owners and Handlers are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs and children and maintaining the cleanliness of their grooming area.

No Smoking in the building!

No dogs may be left in the building overnight.

Please stack crates; No exercise pens; No unentered dogs.

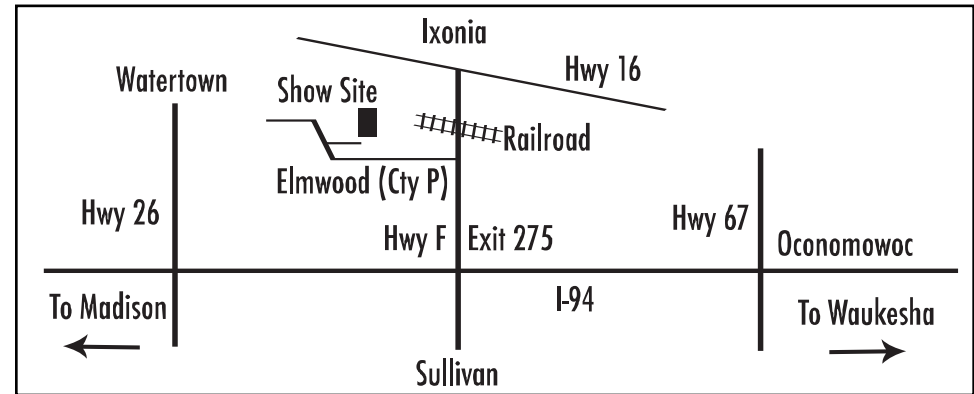

SHOW SITE is approximately 17 miles northwest of Delafield via Interstate 94 West, Concord exit #275 for County Road F. Continue north on County Road F for about 5 miles (lots of curves so be careful); turn left onto Elmwood Drive (before railroad tracks); then take the first right onto Cedar Drive. Show site on left at end of the street (white metal building). See special arrow signs on the corner of County Road F, and Elmwood Drive to direct you to the show site.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

OFFERED ON SATURDAY'S, FIRST SHOW ONLY, AND SUNDAY'S SHOW

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won there (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won there (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won there (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won there (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won there (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won there (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

BEST MASTER HANDLER: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show, and who have won ten (10) first place wins in an Open Class, with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participant return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
